



Inquiry into the Centenary House Lease

Direction – 22 October 2004

Because of the delays which have unavoidably occurred in completing the evidence in the Inquiry, it has become necessary to impose a strict timetable for the completion of the Inquiry within the time allowed for it by the Letters Patent.

1. The valuation evidence of Messrs Egan and McCann will be taken on Thursday and Friday, 28-29 October 2004. Notice of any further documents to be tendered by Counsel assisting the Inquiry will be given prior to 28 October.
2. Counsel assisting the Inquiry are to provide their submissions in writing upon all issues other than the evidence of Messrs Egan and McCann by Friday, 29 October. Their submissions upon the issues raised by the evidence of those two witnesses is to be provided by Monday, 1 November.
3. The submissions of Counsel assisting the Inquiry will be supplied to all parties and to the legal representatives of all witnesses who have been represented during the hearing. Other witnesses or persons claiming a legitimate interest in the terms of reference who wish to receive copies of the submissions are to apply to the Executive Officer of the Inquiry by post at PO Box Q151, QVB Post Office, NSW 1230, or by fax to (02) 9261 3520.
4. Parties, witnesses or other persons claiming a legitimate interest in the terms of reference who wish to make submissions to the Inquiry are to provide their submissions in writing by Monday, 8 November. If any such party, witness or other person wishes to add to their submissions orally, those oral submissions (which must be relatively brief) will be heard on Tuesday, 9 November.
